Other Practical Information:

The City and the County: Oviedo, capital of the “Principado de Asturias”, is an old University town of 210.000 citizens of whom 25.000 approx. are students. It is centrally located in the north of Spain, in between the coast (30 Km) and the well known “Picos de Europa”, impressive mountains, part of the “Cordillera Cantábrica”. Asturias is county which is always green with a mild and rainy climate. The average temperature in May is 15°C.

Travelling: The best way to come to Oviedo is by plane, via Madrid (or Barcelone). Most flights from these hubs are operated by Iberia/British Airways. If you come from Madrid by train (or bus –ALSA Co.), you will have the opportunity of seeing beautiful landscapes of Castilla and Asturias. The travel will last for 5 hours.

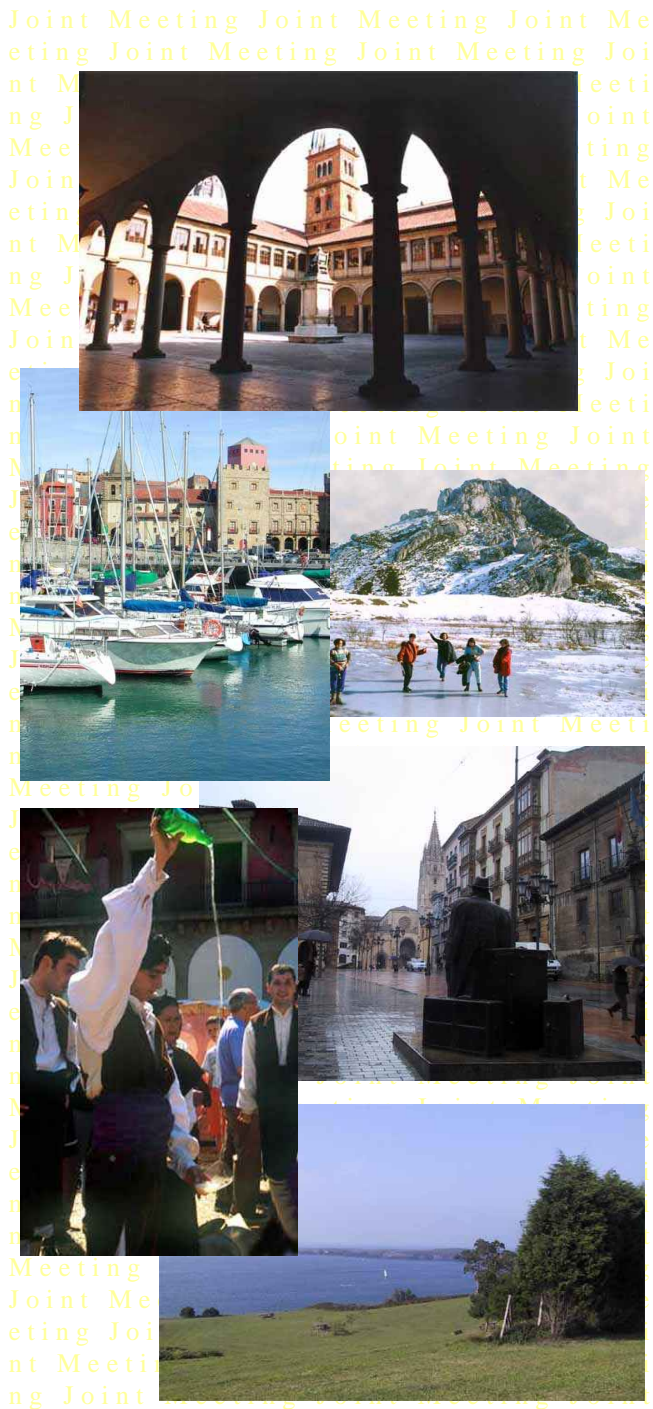
Airport: The Bus service from/to the airport to Oviedo (45 Km) costs about 5 €(one way) and takes 45 min approx. On request to the driver, it can stop by the Hotel Regente and Hotel Campus. From the Bus Station to the Hotel, a Taxi costs 3 €approx. Coming by Taxi from the Airport takes 35 min and you will pay approx. 40 €.

Shopping: Oviedo has very good shops and malls. Apart from shoes, clothes, wines, etc., it is worth paying some attention to a few chocolate shops and typical Asturian food retailers for cheeses and sweets.

Sites to visit: In Oviedo, cathedral, “*Cámara Santa*”, “*Museo de Bellas Artes*”, old pre-romanesque churches, the traditional and old market “*El Fontán*” (Saturday and Sunday mornings), old city bars and discos (especially on Friday and Saturday nights), *Gascona* Street for cider shops and restaurants. Outside Oviedo, by the coast, its twin city, Gijón and also other small typical villages. The mountains (Picos de Europa).
